SUHSD uses the highest of three different tests in order to place students accurately into 9<sup>th</sup> grade mathematics. The three tests used are the 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Smarter Balanced (SBAC) test, the Math Diagnostic Testing Project tests, and the Let's Go Learn Diagnostic Online Math Assessment.

## All incoming 9th graders must take an MDTP test (High School, Geometry, or Algebra II Readiness).

Let's Go Learn DOMA Pre-Algebra and Algebra I assessments are not required.
