## $9^{\text {TH }}$ GRADE MATH PLACEMENT GUIDELINES SEQUOIA UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT

SUHSD uses the highest of three different tests in order to place students accurately into $9^{\text {th }}$ grade mathematics. The three tests used are the $7^{\text {th }}$ Grade Math Smarter Balanced (SBAC) test, the Math Diagnostic Testing Project tests, and the Let's Go Learn Diagnostic Online Math Assessment.

All incoming $9^{\text {th }}$ graders must take an MDTP test (High School, Geometry, or Algebra II Readiness).
Let's Go Learn DOMA Pre-Algebra and Algebra I assessments are not required.
